## **Registration form**

## for Registration and Participation

- 1. A limited number of meals are available every week for local residents of Carnisse. Finished = finished.
- 2. In principle, the Foundation makes these available as a courtesy and there are therefore no rights attached to participation.
- 3. Only registered participants can use this if there are sufficient meals.
- 4. Registration is only possible for people who do not use the food bank. For example, are you single and have less than €400 per month left for food and clothing? Then registration is possible if there are sufficient places available. That €400 is our standard amount for a single person without children. An additional €110 is added for each additional family member. You may be asked to demonstrate this. We may deviate from this in certain cases at our own discretion.
- 5. If there are no more available places, you can be placed on a waiting list. You will then be notified when there is room for you again.
- 6. To register, your name, address and telephone number will be requested.
- 7. If you are registered, we will keep each other informed via a WhatsApp group. You automatically become a member here. Please note that your telephone number will then be visible to others.
- **8.** If you are unable to attend, you must cancel your appointment **no later than 12 noon on the distribution day on Monday.**
- 9. Meals are in principle distributed every Monday between 4:30 PM and 5:30 PM. The doors are closed after 5:30 p.m.
- 10. Anyone who does not deregister on time will be deregistered and will no longer be entitled to a meal. After all, it is not fair to others if there are meals left over
- 11. A voluntary contribution is requested to receive a meal. We try to cover the rest of the costs through donations.
- 12. The meal(s) can only be collected by the registered person. So no meals will be provided for other registered participants. Unless someone is unable to pick up the meals themselves.
- 13. Registered persons who are chronically ill and therefore unable to collect the meals can have a meal delivered if a delivery person is available.
- 14. Everyone is expected to adhere to the instructions of the volunteers.
- 15. Photos and film or TV recordings can be made of the activity. If you object to this, you can make this known when registering.
- 16. A registered person can be deregistered if it appears that someone no longer meets the conditions.
- 17. Shopping cards are from the Red Cross and not from us. We only issue them according to their rules. So there is no point in discussing this with us.
